Notes

1. Entries must be submitted by BROE. Payment must also be by BROE before 25th September. Unpaid entries will not be included in the draw
2. Payment on the day will not be allowed. (see note 1)
3. If only one entry is received in an event, it will automatically be entered for the next higher status unless we are instructed otherwise on BROE. Crews rowing out of division will pay 50% of the entry fee and will not be eligible for a prize.
4. All competitors must be registered competitive members of British Rowing and bring their racing licence with them.
5. *Masters status will depend on entries received. Masters handicaps may be applied.
6. The fastest Mens' and Womens' crews and single scullers will receive pewter tankards. Other class winners will receive RRC medals (subject to rule 3)

Entry Fees

£8.00 per seat for seniors and £5.50 per seat for Juniors. Coxes are free.

Entries close at 8 p.m. on Sunday, 25th September 2016 or earlier if the entry limit is reached.
