UNIQUE ROUND-ROBIN FORMAT ON TWO 300m STRAIGHT COURSES

Held under the Rules of British Rowing and the British Rowing Rules of Racing.



- Races offered for single, double and coxed quad sculls - J13, J14 and J15 - boys and girls.
- Ball Cup North Entry Criteria will apply.
- All crews in a class will race all of the other crews.
- Gold, Silver and Bronze Ball Cup Medals.
- Victor Ludorum trophy for the most successful Club.

FEES AND ENTRY DETAILS

£5.50 PER SEAT - COXES ARE FREE.

Each Club is limited to 18 entries - The total entries are limited to 130.

Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and will be capped when a status is full in order to provide a full regatta programme.

Entries and payment via BROE only. Closing date is Sunday 19th June 2016 at 8pm or before if the 130 crew limit is reached.

The regatta is run on a Round Robin format – using two 300m straight courses. Each crew will race every other crew in the class – so all crews are on the water at the same time. e.g. If you enter three J13 scullers for instance, they will each need their own boat and blades.

All competitors must be registered racing members of British Rowing.

Payment must be received before the closing date for the entry to be added to the draw.

Doubling up is encouraged but all details must be notified on BROE including boat and cox doubling.

The draw will be held at the address below on Tuesday 21st June at 7.30pm.
