



# Runcorn Autumn Head of the River Weaver on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2019

J18, 17, 16 and 15, Seniors and Masters will race over the 4,500m course from the White Gate to Sutton Weaver.  
Junior 14 and below will race over the 2,250m course from Old Moat Wood to Sutton Weaver.  
British Rowing's Rules of Racing shall apply.

## Notes

1. Entries must be submitted by BROE2.
2. If only one entry is received in an event, it will automatically be entered for the next higher status unless instructed otherwise on BROE2. Crews rowing out of division will pay 50% of the fee and will not be eligible for a prize.
3. All competitors must be registered competitive members of British Rowing and bring their race licence with them.
4. \*Masters status will depend on entries received. Master handicaps may be applied.; we welcome entries from inexperienced crews (typically no more than 3 years' rowing) which will be banded to race based on average ranking points and the number of entries.
5. The fastest Mens' and Womens' crews and single scullers will receive pewter tankards. Other class winners will receive RRC medals – subject to Note 2

## Entry Fees

£9:00 per seat for seniors and £6.00 per seat for juniors. Coxes are free.

Entries close at 18:00 on Friday 19th September 2019 or earlier if the entry limit is reached.

Payment must be by BROE2 by Friday 19th September 2019 : Unpaid entries will not be included in the draw; Payment on the day will not be allowed.
